J U D G M E N T

This action came on for trial before the Court, Mr. Justice Bulman presiding, and the issues having been tried and a decision having been duly rendered,

And thereafter in three conferences in chambers counsel for the parties having been unable to agree on a form of judgment which would specifically delineate that part of defendant's land which would be subject to the reasonable exercise of plaintiffs' right of way,

It is ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

That defendant be, and he hereby is, permanently enjoined and restrained from interfering with plaintiffs' right to pass and repass with automobiles over and along that part of defendant's land which is reasonably necessary to the exercise of said right; and

From interfering with plaintiffs' right to use a reasonably necessary area at the southerly (beach) end of said way in which to turn automobiles around; and
